


Video Sharing from Motorola

Share real-time video for improved decision making and situational response.

Fence motion sensors trigger a camera recording at the county jail, and video from the cameras is automatically pushed to a monitor. A prisoner is seen on screen as he escapes from the facility. The officer on duty at the command center immediately dispatches patrol cars and transmits the video of the suspect over a wireless Mesh network to mobile computers. As patrol cars make a sweep of the neighborhood, an officer's Mobile Video Enforcer (MVE) in-vehicle camera records the escapee. With just one-click, that officer shares the streaming video with other officers who are able to assess the situation in real-time. The prisoner is apprehended just a few blocks away and responding officers are unharmed.

Video Sharing from Motorola will enable users connected to a broadband wireless network, like MOTOMESH™, to share video to and from a wired location such as a command center. Video can be viewed from cameras associated with other responders—police, fire, or EMS. Other sources which can be shared include fixed locations such as surveillance cameras, logged video from a recorder or camera in a vehicle, or from Motorola's Intelligent Video Surveillance and Control (iVSC).
