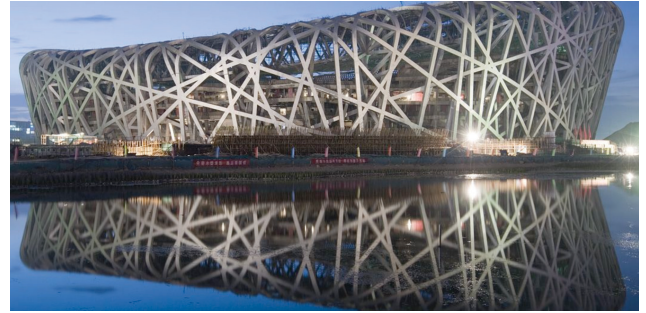

Why TETRA for Major Events

The smooth running of major events, from basic co-ordination to high-end policing, is underpinned by secure, resilient communications. Without effective communication, the organisation of an event can become chaotic, endangering the safety and security of all involved. A robust TETRA (TErrestrial TRunked Radio) network provides effective voice and data communications to maintain control and coordination, not only for the event organisers, but also public safety, transportation and other key workers. Motorola's TETRA solutions offer the user a proven and efficient communication system, not only for today but for many years to come.

A long history of successfully supporting events

Motorola has a long history of supporting major sporting, cultural and other events. Here are just a few examples of events where Motorola's TETRA solution has been successfully used:

- **China, 2010:** Provided six TETRA Systems for Public Security and Transportation to help ensure the smooth running of Shanghai Expo where 70million visitors are expected
- **Denmark 2009:** Motorola TETRA system supported 6,000 police officers over 14 days, helping to ensure the safety of over 60 world leaders at the 2009 COP15 climate summit in Copenhagen.
- **Singapore, from 2008:** Provided secure, resilient TETRA communications to support the Singapore Grand Prix, the first Formula 1 night race.
- **China, 2008:** Beijing attracted over 5M visitors to watch the Olympics in 2008. Motorola supplied over 60,000 radios to support Beijing Police, Beijing Metro, Beijing Light Rail, Beijing Capital Airport Express Rail and the Beijing General Station of Exit and Entry Frontier Inspection Unit.
- **Austria, 2008:** The Motorola TETRA system functioned without problem to help ensure safety during Euro2008:

- **Germany, 2007:** Provided a complete TETRA solution in only 3 months to support 2007 G8 summit in Heiligendamm, Germany

- **Scotland, 2005:** The UK's nationwide Airwave network supported the 2005 G8 summit in Scotland.
- **Korea, 2005:** Motorola's TETRA systems supported both public safety and transportation requirements during the 13th APEC Summit in Busan
- **Isle of Man, from 2004:** Our nationwide public safety system provides resilient communications year round and is critical to support famous TT motorcycle races. Indeed, the TETRA network is so important that the race would not get insurance without it!
- **China, 2004:** Delivered first digital trunking systems in a Sports Centre in China to support the 10th all China Games in Nanjing
- **Greece, 2004:** Over 200,000 calls were made a day during the Olympics. The system was such a success that the Greek government has continued to use the system for its public safety agencies
- **Russia, 2004:** Complete network supplied and implemented in just 4 weeks to support EU-Russia Summit in Samara
- **Korea 2002:** Very fast turnaround from order to operational system for the Korea National Police to support the 2002 World Cup
