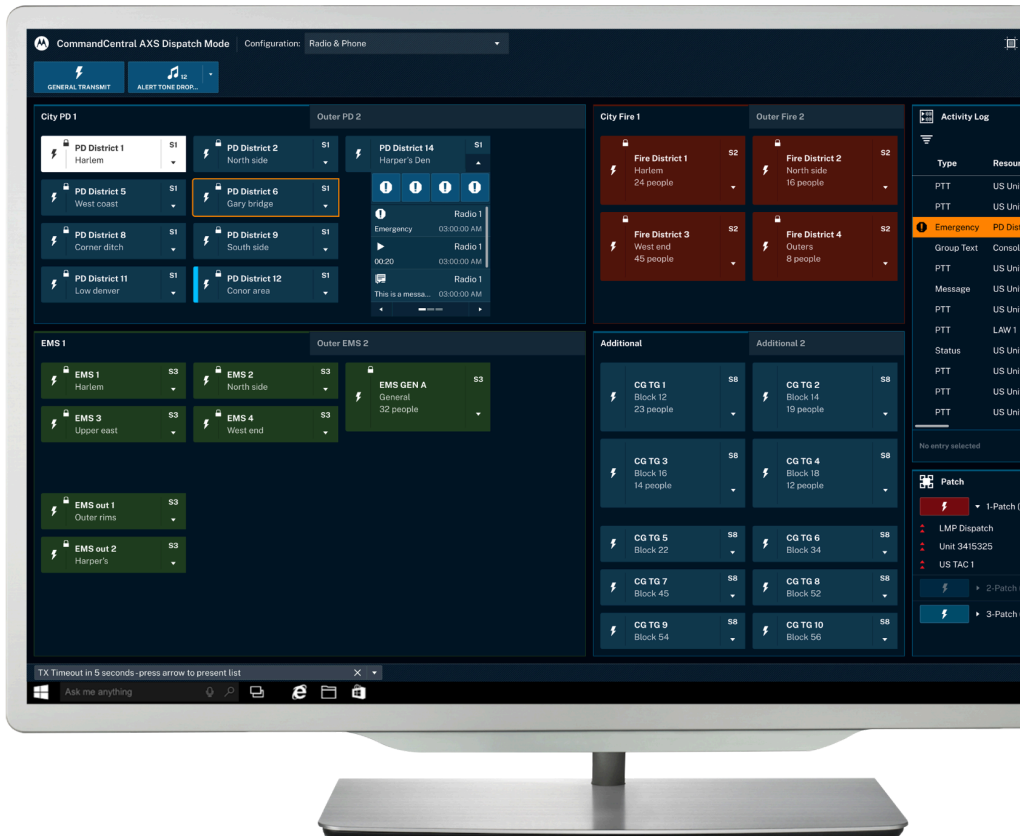


CommandCentral AXS Release 3.6 Feature Brief

Here's what's new for CommandCentral AXS R3.6

1. ACTIVITY LOG PLACEMENT

The resizing and moveability of the Activity Log has been enhanced to make it easier to place in desired locations on the AXS user interface.

2. EXPANDED RADIO RESOURCE VIEW

Radio resources can now be placed on the user interface in an expanded view. This removes the need to first open the radio resource to access the resource's quick action button and expansion panels on the carousel. Both the compressed and expanded view can be configured independently. When a user grabs and places the resource onto a tab, the resources preferred view is used. The user may override the preferred view.

3. PRIMARY RESOURCE DESIGNATION

Resources can now be added to the Primary Resource group. Primary radio resources display a diamond on the resource to identify a higher handling priority to the dispatcher. Enabling emergency indications per talkgroup can now be done based on whether the radio resource is designated as a primary resource or not. Editing the primary list of resources is accomplished in the radio resource list via the Edit Primary button. This allows for easy filtering of the list. The administrator can choose to lock the list when editing or allow the dispatcher to edit it.

4. RECEIVED CALL STACK RIGHT CLICK OPTIONS

The administrator may select which emergency feature options are available when right clicking on an entry in the Received Call Stack for a radio resource. The administrator may choose to remove the Acknowledge Emergency and/or Knockdown Emergency options from this list. This is dependent upon the available emergency features configured in the Provisioning Manager for the resource. All provisioned features are available by default. This is configured on a per resource basis.

5. RADIO RESOURCE EXPANSION PANEL OPTIONS

The administrator may select which expansion panels are shown to the dispatcher on a radio resource's carousel. The administrator may choose to show any combination of the Received Call Stack, Speaker Assignment, Emergency Alarm, and/or Signaling expansion panels. All panels are shown by default. This is configured on a per resource basis.

6. 200 SIMULTANEOUS RADIO RESOURCE ASSIGNMENTS

CommandCentral AXS console is now capable of supporting up to 200 unique affiliated trunking and/or conventional resources per dispatch position. This is an increase from the previous limit of 160.
