New Feature: Menu Button Expansion

The V200 includes an on-device menu which has been enabled to allow device operator to perform the following actions:

- Pair a new LMR radio device with the V200 using Bluetooth
- Reconnect to the previously paired LMR radio device via Bluetooth
- Power off the V200 device

New Feature: Menu Button Lock

Alongside the introduction of the Menu Button functionality an Admin has the ability to lock/disable the on-device menu through VideoManager, preventing menu access if desired.

New Feature: Peer Assisted Recording (PAR)

The V200 now includes Peer Assisted Recording (PAR) support, operating identically to the VB400 and V500. It can transmit and accept PAR requests to trigger recording on nearby peer devices or vice versa.

New Feature: No Record Zone (NRZ)

The No Record Zone (NRZ) feature automatically disables V200 recording upon entering private spaces equipped with Bluetooth BLE beacons. Using Received Signal Strength Indicator (RSSI) detection of these beacons, the V200 identifies the area and stops recording without user intervention.

- The V200 can detect up to 1,000 beacons; however configuring more than 1,000 beacons is not recommended.

New Feature: Separate Audio Tracks

Administrators can select between original and noise-cancelled audio when reviewing recorded video footage that has been offloaded to VideoManager.

New Feature: Bookmarking

Users can now create bookmarks at specific moments during a recording, with the corresponding timestamps subsequently viewable within Video Manager.

New Feature: Recording LED Customization

Administrators are now able to customize the V200 recording LED beyond the standard "Solid Red" option. New selectable configurations, including "Solid Green" and "Blinking Red," have been introduced for recording LED customization.
