Changes since V26.2.0.34

SAML authentication support

VideoManager introduced SAML 2.0 as an authentication method in V26.2.0.34. From this release, it will no longer require an advanced setting to be activated, and can be found in Admin > Users > Authentication methods - New Realm.

mTLS support for API connections in VideoManager Cloud

VideoManager now supports mTLS connections to the API for VideoManager Cloud customers. This feature requires configuration by the Cloud team, please contact support if you require this feature.

MS SQL database users - potential breaking change - *action required before upgrade*

Due to an update to the SQL Server JDBC driver (9.4.1 -> 13.4.0), connections to the database now enable TLS by default. Depending on the connection string currently in use, an error may be shown in the VMEX logs after upgrade:

"'encrypt' property is set to 'true' and 'trustServerCertificate' property is set to 'false' but the driver could not establish a secure connection to SQL Server by using Secure Sockets Layer"

If TLS is not required, then adding the option `'encrypt=false'` to the connection string will restore the previous behaviour. We recommend doing this **before upgrading VideoManager** to avoid problems, otherwise VideoManager will fail to start after the upgrade.

Performance improvement for Media report

If you have experienced issues with the Media report taking a long time to generate since 26.1 release, this release will improve this.

Auror integration - auto population of Site ID

The custom field associated with the site id is now auto-filled as an enumeration/drop down, with data taken directly from Auror. The user now chooses the site ID from the drop-down when creating the incident.

Device related updates

Include all button presses in the audit log (V500 & VB400 only)

When enabled, all button presses and gesture intents will be logged, even if they are not programmed to perform any action. Enable in: Admin > Devices > Device Settings. Requires device firmware 26.1 onwards.

V500 SmartDock security improvement

A security improvement has been applied to this device. We recommend all SmartDock users upgrade to the latest SmartDock firmware 26.2.0.36.

Minor enhancements

VMEX-6385	Updated SQL Server JDBC driver from 9.4.1 to 13.4.0 Due to an update to the SQL Server JDBC driver, connections to the database now enable TLS by default.
