Corrections

Issue	Description	
M500 False Crash Detection	False crash detections observed in some units in the field. Th accelerometer can produce large g-force readings at rest and may only occur based on the DVR installation orientation. Accelerometer calibration is now executed on every boot and used to adjust the g-force readings.	
Covert Mode - Event Time Limit issue	When the stop button is pressed to exit covert mode, the 'Event Time Limit' dialog appears early, and the 'Extend' button is unresponsive

#	Limitations	Workaround
	Long start time after upgrade	Wait for the upgrade to complete
1	After a software upgrade, the unit may take 10 minutes to completely start again while the upgrade is applied. The splash screen will indicate that an upgrade is in progress.	
It is possible to get stuck on the disk check screen on startup. When this occurs, it is normally the result of sudden power loss occurring multiple times, and may indicate a problem with the power wiring or shutdown timer configuration settings.		After 40 minutes have passed, the unit should function as expected. Leave the system running for at least 20 minutes after recovery to ensure sufficient charging of the supercaps. Note that the supercap charge is now shown under the Home->Utilities->Diagnostics menu.
2	The message on the display indicates the recovery could take up to 40 minutes.
