New Feature: Motorola Radio Integration via Bluetooth

V200 supports radio integration with MOTOTRBO models. This functionality enables a bluetooth connection between the V200 and MOTOTRBO devices, allowing the V200 to initiate or activate recording when the MOTOTRBO radio emergency button is pressed. Currently, support is limited to the following MOTOTRBO radio models:

- R7
- R5
- DP4401e, DP4601e, DP4801e
- DP3441e, DP3661e
- DM4601e

New Feature: Discreet Escalation (Panic Button)

The V200 now features discreet escalation, allowing for silent triggering using the standard escalation button gesture. Discreet and standard escalation are mutually exclusive. By default, discreet escalation uses haptic-only feedback, though users can customize haptic and LED settings.

New Feature: Configurable Tones & Haptics for Escalation or Live Streaming

V200 notifications for joining or exiting a live stream are now fully configurable. Users have the option to enable or disable both haptic feedback and audible tones for live streaming.

New Feature: Default Volume Control & Locked Volume Control

V200 audio settings have been enhanced with a default volume control and an additional volume lock toggle. Users can now set a preferred default volume and choose to either enable or disable volume adjustments via the V200 volume buttons.

New Feature: Standby Mode

New power management settings have been introduced for the V200, allowing users to configure the device to enter a standby state during periods of inactivity.

New Feature: Power Button Gesture

New button combinations have been implemented for managing V200 device power. The device will remain unresponsive to button presses until the power-on sequence is completed.

Improvements:

- Added signal strength to the WiFi icon to reflect the current connection status of the device.
- Live Streaming audio and haptics have been enhanced to improve the user experience near the edge of WiFi coverage

Fixes:

V200-2688	During a critical low battery condition, the device displays an alert on the LCD screen and front LED first, followed by the alert tone after about 20 minutes.
V200-1836 V200-1794	Live streaming feedback (beeps/vibrate) can become overwhelming if the device is on the edge of the WiFi range and continuously stops and starts
V200-3361	Suppress recording on undock does not work when using WiFi docking.
