#### DETECT

## KNOWN PERSON IDENTIFIED

An automatic license plate reader recognizes a banned individual's vehicle entering the stadium parking lot. An alert is automatically sent to stadium operations directly on their device of choice and in the command center

## **COMMUNICATE**

**NOTIFICATION** COMMUNICATED

Security staff are notified of the situation and an image of the banned individual is sent to prevent entry.





#### **ANALYZE**

#### SITUATIONAL INTELLIGENCE GATHERED

Cameras within relevant parking area populated and the closest security personnel are identified.

#### RESPOND **INCIDENT MANAGED AND** REPORTED

Stadium operations monitor the situation via fixed video and live streaming body worn cameras. An incident report is logged with pre-populated fields and relevant data.
