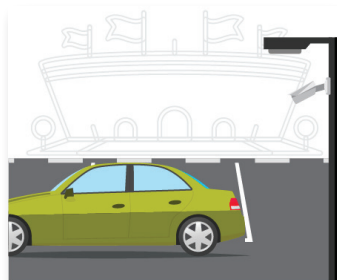


# USE CASE BANNED INDIVIDUAL

## Safer Stadiums

### Operational View



#### DETECT

##### KNOWN PERSON IDENTIFIED

An automatic license plate reader recognizes a banned individual's vehicle entering the stadium parking lot. An alert is automatically sent to stadium operations directly on their device of choice and in the command center.



#### ANALYZE

##### SITUATIONAL INTELLIGENCE GATHERED

Cameras within relevant parking area populated and the closest security personnel are identified.



#### COMMUNICATE

##### NOTIFICATION COMMUNICATED

Security staff are notified of the situation and an image of the banned individual is sent to prevent entry.



#### RESPOND

##### INCIDENT MANAGED AND REPORTED

Stadium operations monitor the situation via fixed video and live streaming body worn cameras. An incident report is logged with all relevant data.
