Junior Year | Fall

Students take the October preliminary SAT / National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT / NMSQT)



Senior Year | Fall

Students qualifying as semifinalists receive scholarship application materials and instructions from the NMSC



Senior Year | Winter

Completed applications reviewed by the NMSC to determine finalists



Senior Year | Spring

Official scholarship offers sent to selected award winners by the NMSC
